This session will discuss foundational information of sexual violence, including core facts related to sexual violence (common dynamics between people involved, prevalence rates, rate of false reports) and key definitions (power, consent, coercion, forms of sexual violence). We will also discuss the impacts of sexual violence and then work on responding skills for supporting someone who has experienced sexual violence. We will end our session by providing community referral agencies and a description of SACE services.


