- Participating in the strengthening of the draft report


Speakers:

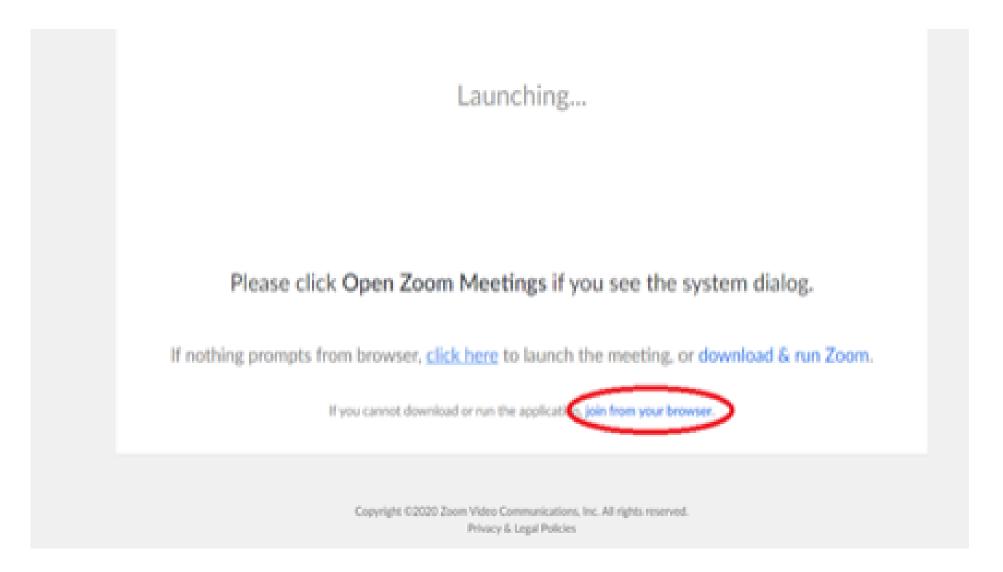
