
Head Lice: Information for Public Health Nurses

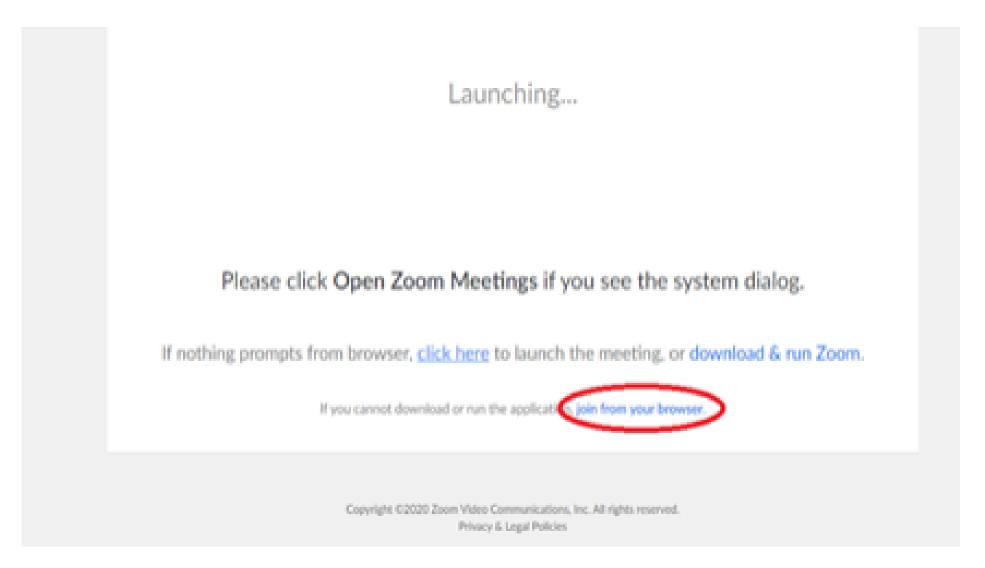
