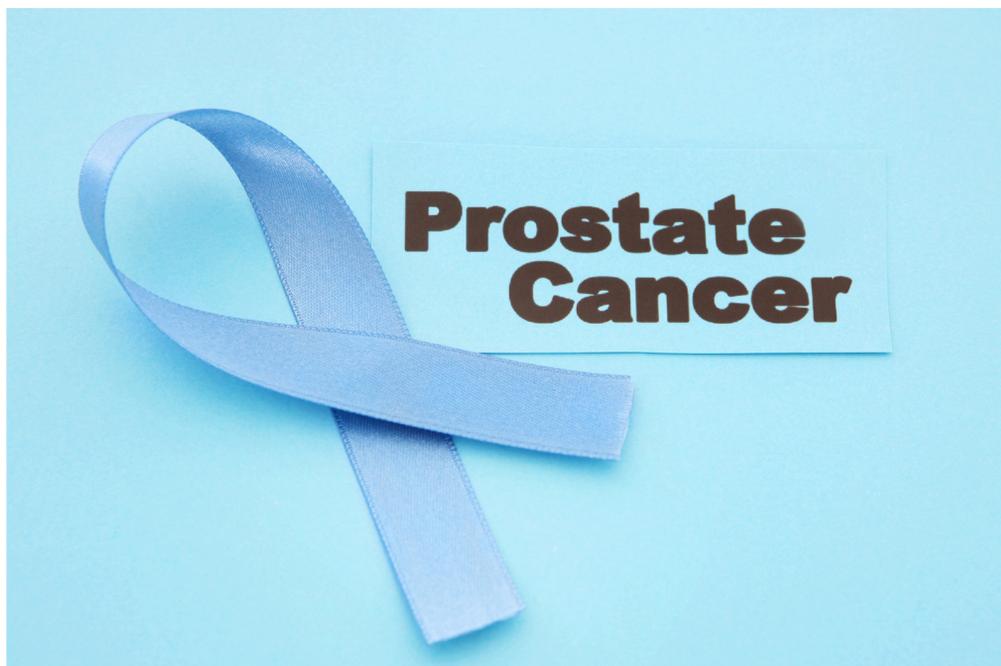


# Prostate Cancer Basics & the MAN VAN: Bringing Men's Healthcare to the Community

This session will provide an overview of the basics of prostate cancer, including risk factors, testing, and the importance of early detection. Participants will also learn about the MAN VAN program and how it helps bring accessible health education and testing services directly into communities across Alberta.



## Learning Outcomes:

- Understand the fundamentals of prostate cancer and why early detection matters
- Identify common risk factors and warning signs associated with prostate cancer
- Describe the role of PSA testing in prostate health
- Explain how the MAN VAN initiative supports men's health through outreach and community-based services

## Speakers:

Camille Scheible, MAN VAN Program Director at the Prostate Cancer Centre. In my role overseeing the MAN VAN Program, I supported the delivery of 51 clinics in Indigenous communities between 2024-2025, working to improve access to prostate cancer testing and education. Recognizing the importance of culturally informed engagement, I established an Indigenous Liaison role within the program, which led to the development of specialized cultural safety and sensitivity training for the entire MAN VAN team to ensure respectful, community-centered care

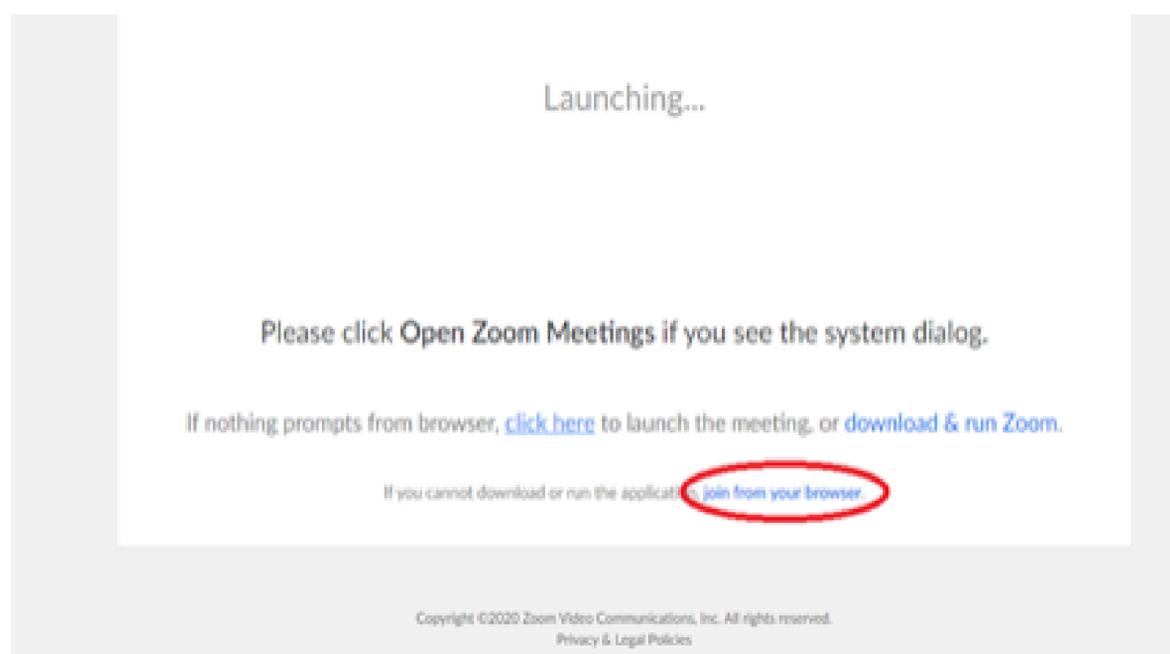
