

"Use that occurs when someone uses drugs or alcohol in a harmful way that has negative effects on their health and life."






# Prevention: Substance Use

# What we have learned:


- Fear appeals (stories of someone else's drug use, mock crashes) do not always have the intended outcome
- Health education and information alone does not prevent substance use
- The best approach is comprehensive and coordinated community action!

# How to Increase Youth Engagement


- Focus on healthy supportive youthadult partnerships


