

We advocate for our clients to help them rebuild their lives and to pave the way for others who follow


We believe that punishment is not the antidote for addiction


We see empowerment as a powerful tool for wellness


We believe that a positive and effective work environment happens when:

- We recognize that we are all in this together



VODP

VODP: a public and entirely virtual OAT provider in Alberta.


- Leverage existing technologies such as telehealth, videoconference (ZOOM), telephone and text to connect providers to clients;
- Rapid access to treatment medications **<u>anywhere</u>** in Alberta.

Key Elements:

- <u>All</u> encounters are virtual;
- Clients **do not need a referral**, but often come from corrections, emergency departments, detox or other settings. Self referred most common;
- Once stabilized, transition clients to services in own community (if they exist);
- Provide ongoing care when local services absent.

Methodology: Service Model of Care:

- Every door the right door "How can we help you today";
- Start treatment now! Sort out where we are going later (anything is safer than fentanyl);
- Same Day Starts / Transition Services / Ongoing Care.





How Much Contact Is Enough?



•OAT doesn't have to be binary. We can use it to reduce harm when a client has ongoing use.







Conclusions
