Since 2013, Capri has been in her current role as the Clinical Administration Manager at Aventa Centre of Excellence for Women with Addictions. Over her career, Capri has worked with many Indigenous people and organizations including most recently organizing the group "Elder Support: Restoring Our Strength" for Aventa Clients. At Aventa, approximately 36% of our Clients are Indigenous.

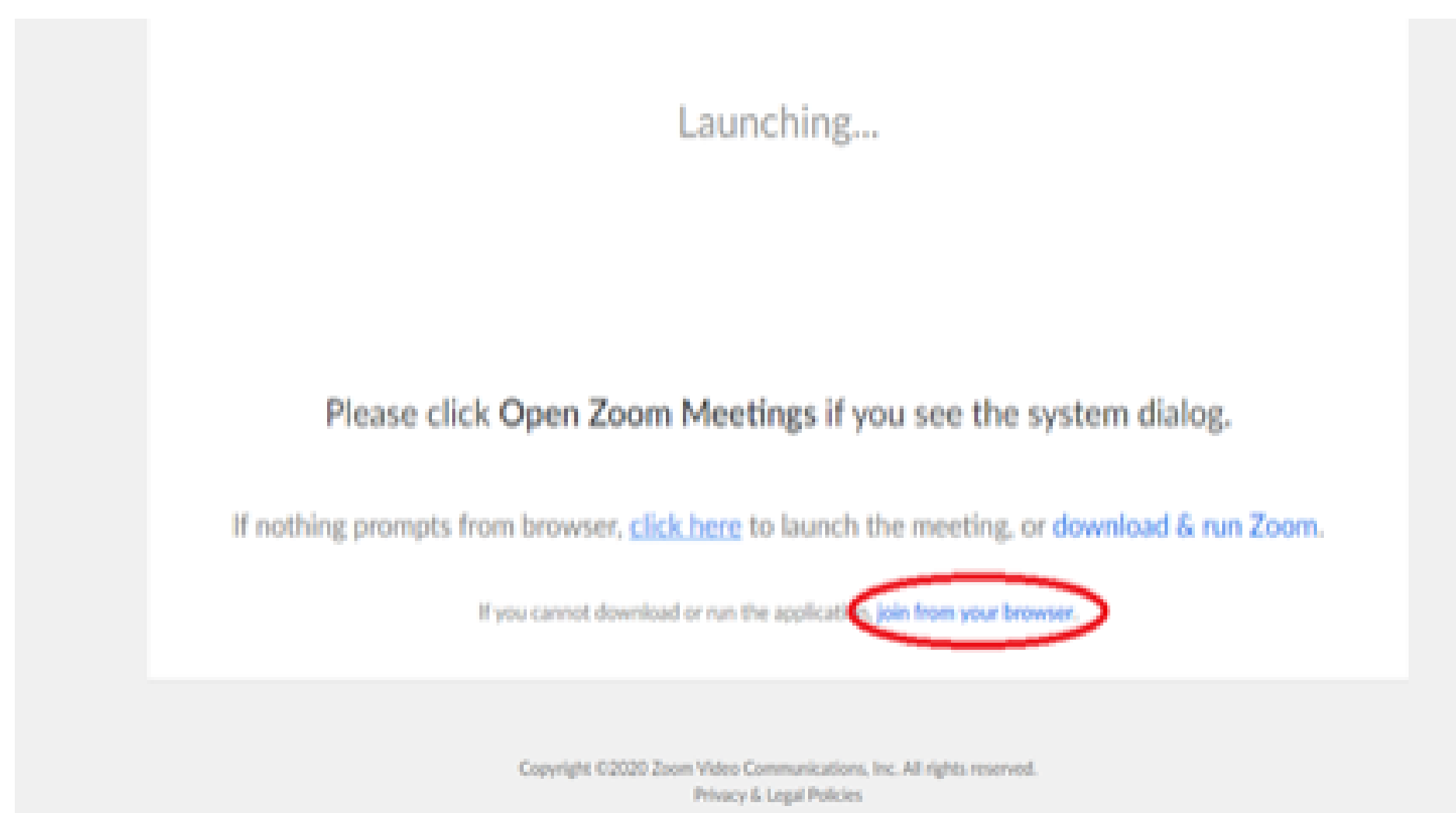
