
Source Water Protection Planning May 16, 2024 10:00-11:30am MST

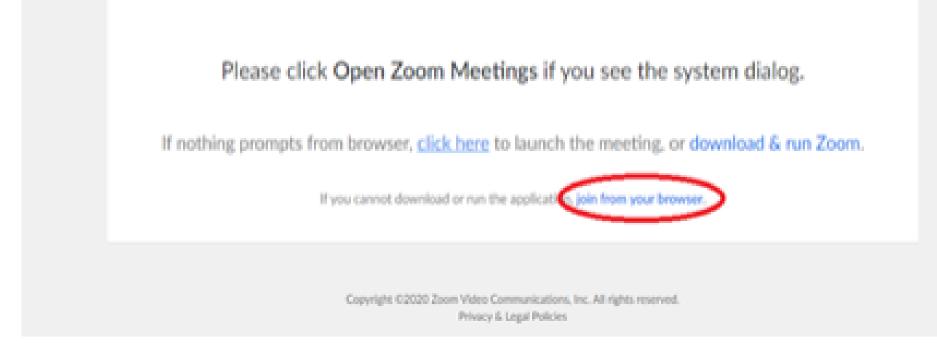
