
Prostate Cancer Information to Help Healthcare Providers Support their Patients October 9, 2024 1:30-2:30pm MDT

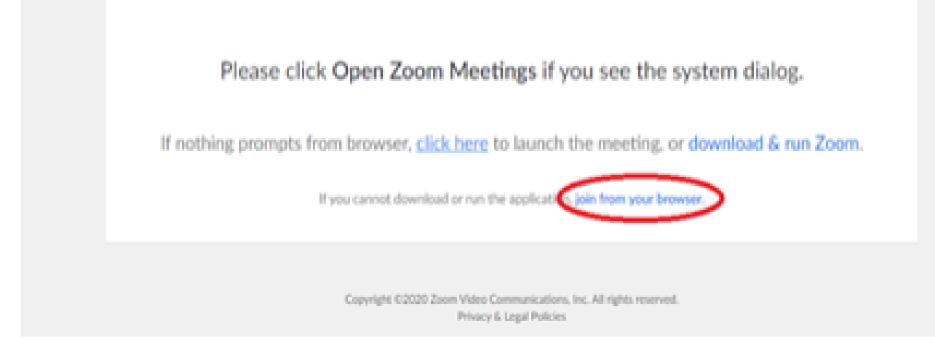
