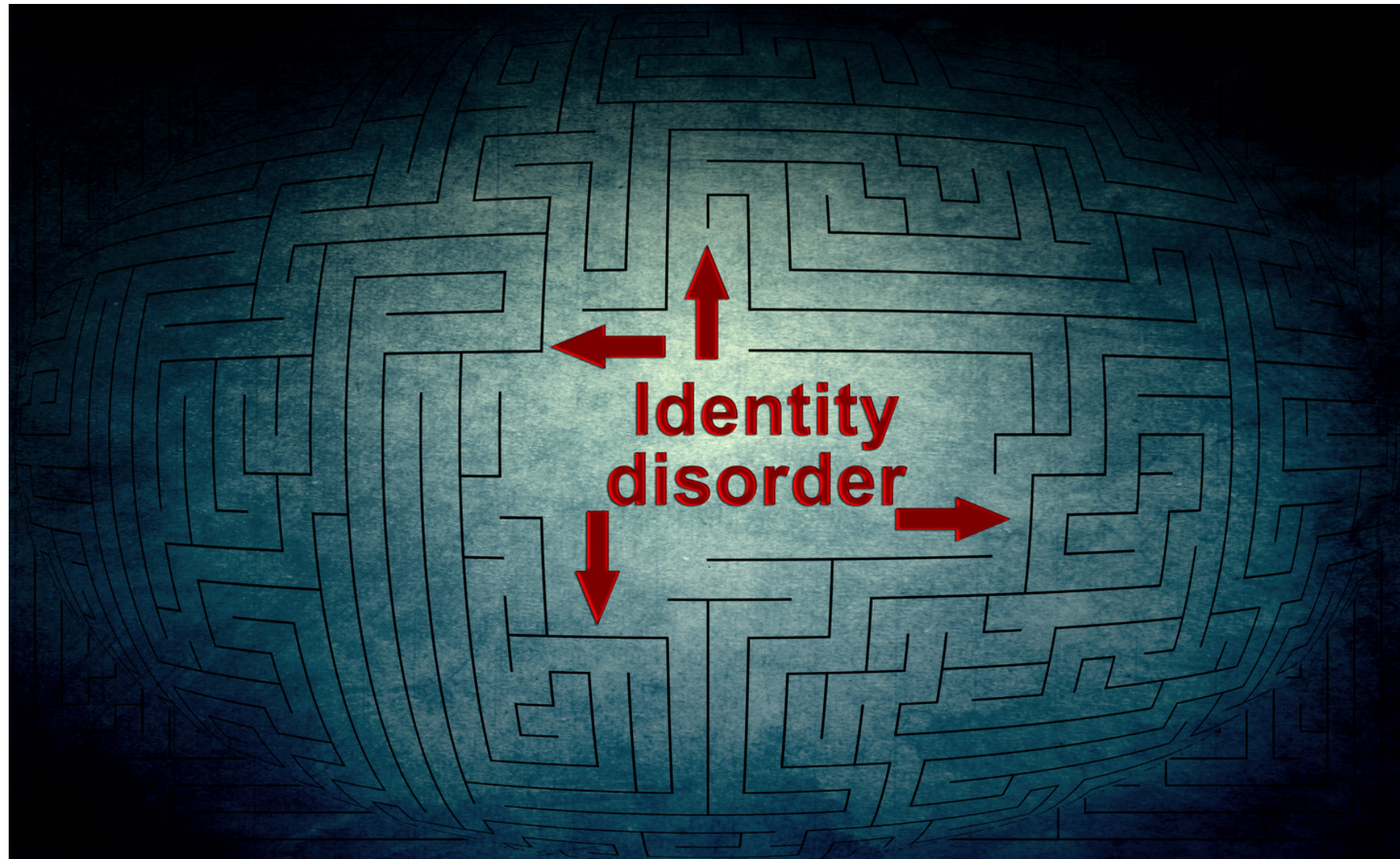


# Do Multiple Personalities Exist? Dissociative Identity Disorder

Amy has been in the helping field for 20 years, and has been in private practice for many of these. Amy works with adults around concerns with mental health, gender and sexuality, trauma and dissociative disorders, and structural oppression. She has some experience working with Indigenous clients and regularly engages in learning, activism and education around Indigenous folk's experience of genocide, trauma and oppression. In a broader sense, Amy prioritizes both racialized and queer individuals as students, supervisees, and clients by offering affordable services and/or supervision



Target Audience: Adults looking to understand dissociation in general as well as dissociative experiences like DID from a non-pathologizing and judgement free perspective. Folks with little or no knowledge of DID will benefit most from this session, however professionals can also benefit if looking for information and understanding from a non-psychiatric perspective
