Indigenous Veterans Initiative: Providing Grave Markers to Indigenous Veterans November 25, 2024 1:30-2:30pm MST

Come learn about the Indigenous Veterans Initiative (IVI). The IVI is an important step towards reconciliation and recognizing the large number of Indigenous Veterans that served in the Canadian Armed Force. According to Veterans Affairs Canada over 12,000 Indigenous Veterans served in the World Wars and Korea. And many continue to serve today in the Canadian Armed Forces. In the last 5 years we have placed over 270 grave markers for Indigenous Veterans that were lying in an unmarked grave, working with over 40 communities across Canada. All this research could not be possible without the help of dedicated community researchers.


