SIDS is very sad and has a deep impact on parents - and a wide circle of family, friends, whole communities. SIDS seems mysterious but there is a standard investigation with the Medical Examiner we will describe. We will make suggestions - but need your help - in understanding if all international recommendations to reduce the risk of SIDS apply to First Nations Communities, which recommendations are most important and how we can work with First Nations to ensure fewer babies die.


