

Strengthening Families through Preventive and Reunification Supports: The WOLFE Family

Wellness Model

This session will provide an overview of WOLFE Family Wellness and our preventative, reunification-focused programming designed to keep children out of care and safely return children home. Participants will learn how our holistic, family-centred model supports complex families through structured programming, accountability, and collaboration with community partners. We will also explore how telehealth partnerships can enhance access to care for families in programs such as WOLFE.



Learning Outcomes:

- Understand WOLFE's 90-day intensive family wellness preventative and reunification model
- Learn how preventative programming reduces child intervention involvement
- Identify opportunities for telehealth integration within residential and community-based family services
- Gain insight into culturally responsive approaches when working with Indigenous families

Jordyn and Soraya lead the organization's preventative and reunification-focused programming, supporting families involved with child intervention and working to keep children out of care safely. Together, they bring experience collaborating with First Nations families and community partners, using culturally responsive, strength-based approaches that prioritize family preservation, accountability, and long-term stability.


