She is a panel member for the Calgary Aboriginal Restorative Youth Justice Committee, a member of Alberta Court of Justice Access to Justice Through an Indigenous Lens Committee, and is appointed to Calgary Aboriginal Urban Affairs Committee for a two-year term. She has walked the path of the Red Road and the work it took to overcome Intergenerational trauma. The wisdom she has gained and continues to gain is an important and integral part of her leadership for her team and service for organization's clients

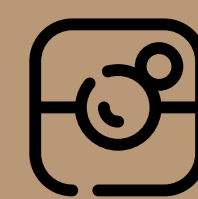

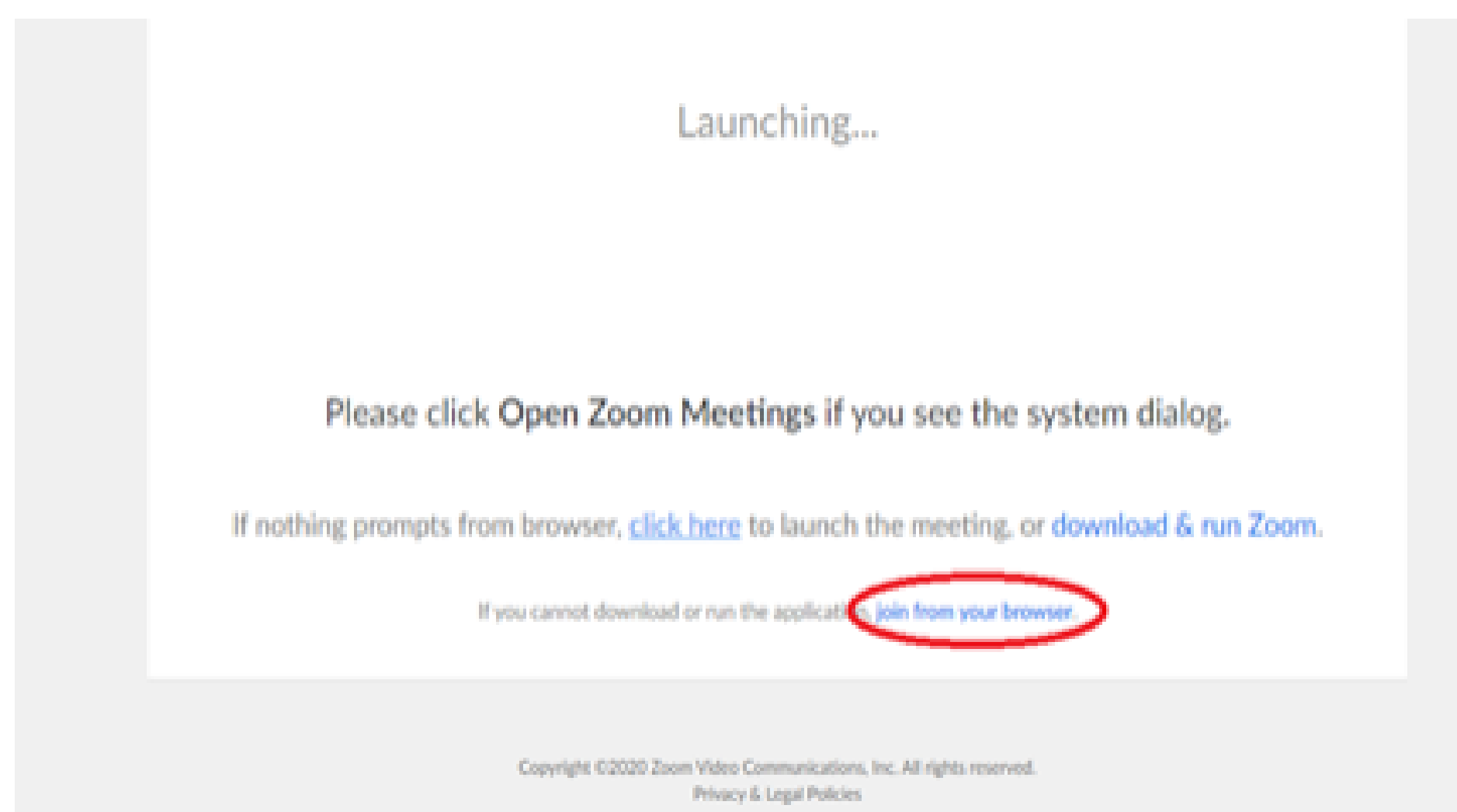
