

Virtual Diabetes Support Opportunities



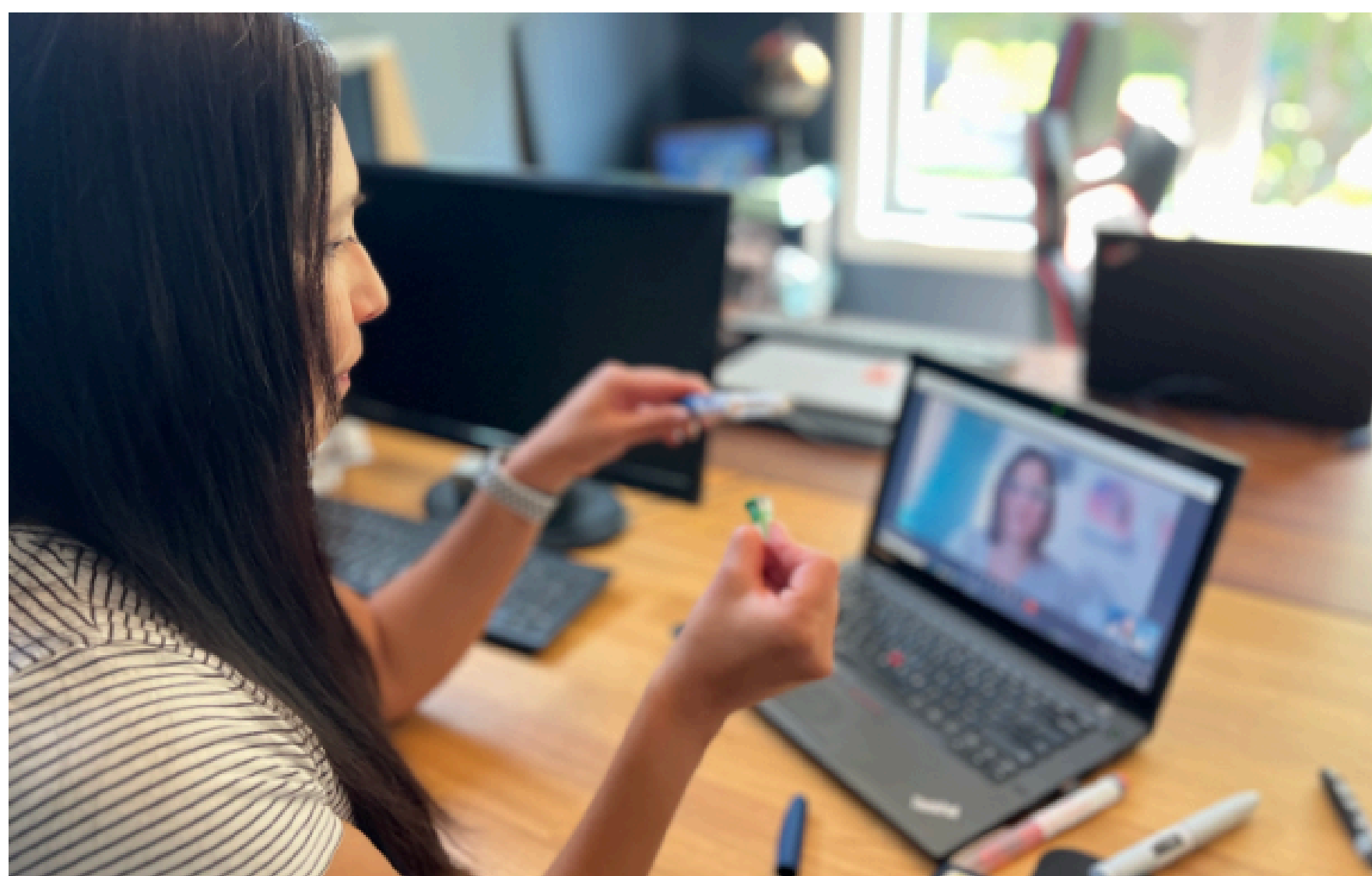

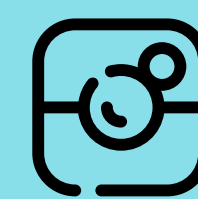

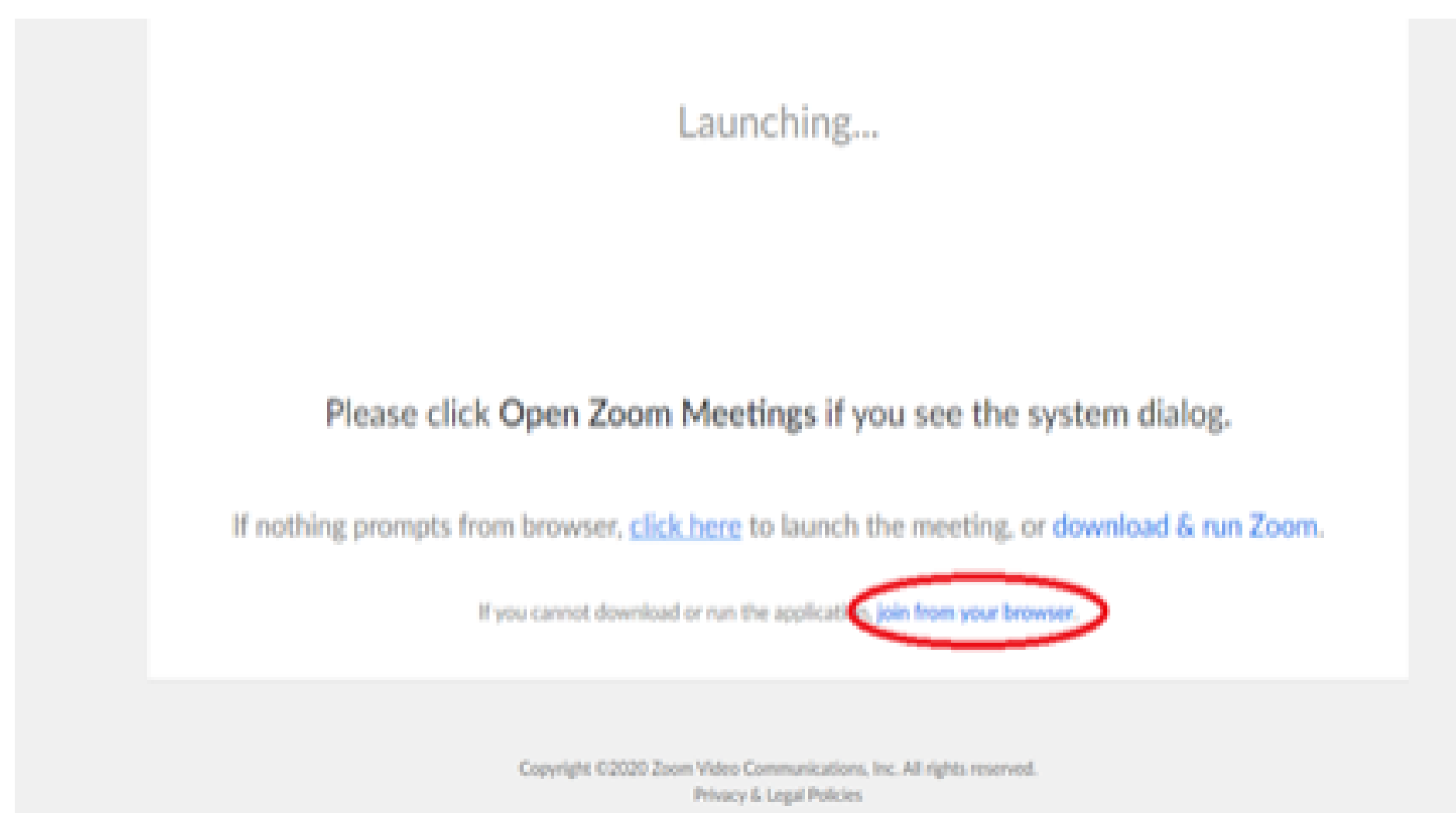
