A practical review of the CHIP SLICE School Age Report Tickler. Learn how to use the School-Age Tickler to quickly identify students who are eligible for school-age vaccines or who need catch-up doses of childhood vaccines. The session also covers how to export and print lists to support the parental consent process.

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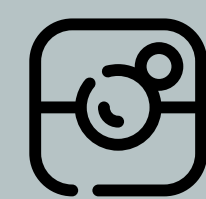
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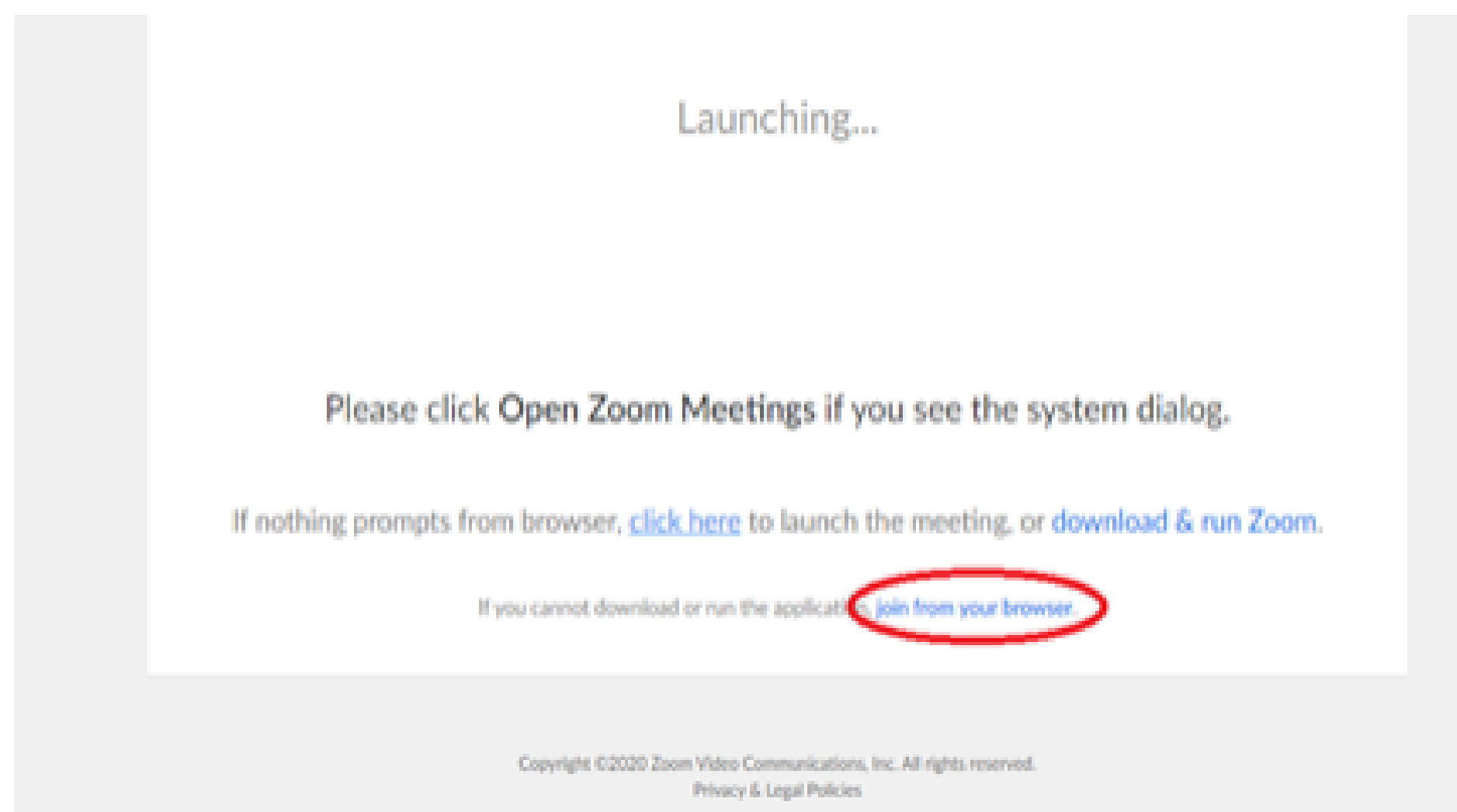
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
